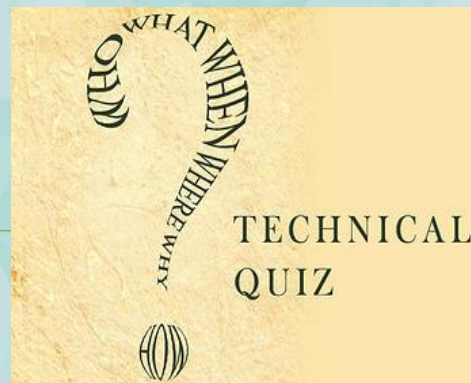

A Brief Note on Competitions

1. Quiz Competition: Rs. 30/- per member

The 1st round for this competition will be followed by objective question paper which consists of 25 questions for half an hour duration. A merit list will be prepared for 8 candidates based on the performance in the quiz exam.

In 2nd round these 8 students will be seated on the dice and technical questions will be asked by jury members sequentially from 1 to 8. For every right answer candidate will get 10 marks and for every wrong answer a deduction of 5 marks will be permitted. The first 4 who secured maximum marks in this round will be eligible for 3rd round of this competition.

In 3rd round visual clips, Photographs/ images will be displayed in front of candidates once again for every correct answer candidate will be awarded by 10 marks and a deduction of 5 marks on every wrong answer.

The 1st and 2nd Highest scorers will be the final winners of the quiz competition.

2. Research Paper Competition Rs. 30/- per member
