Explaining the details about the weather station Prof. Chintan Pathak told:

- AWS at IPSA, records seven quantities right now, namely: temperature, humidity, solar radiation, wind speed, wind direction, atmospheric pressure and rainfall.
- > The weather data is also stored in a database and uploaded to other websites for aggregation with world weather data.
- > The data is in public domain and can be used by anyone around the world.
