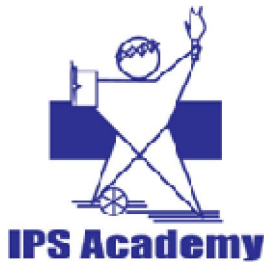

Felicitation of our chief guest was done by our head, Prof. Manish Sahajwani.

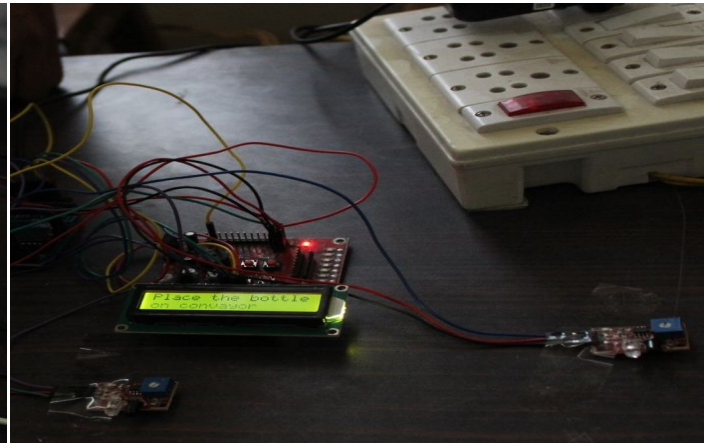
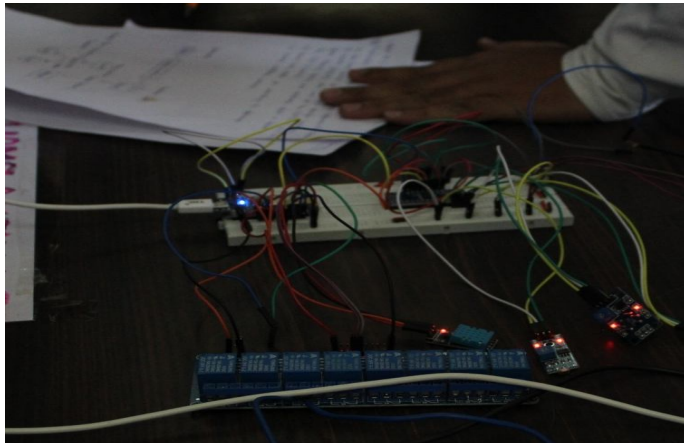
