Leave Management System (LMS)

Leave management System (LMS) covers Leave Application of Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff, Viewing Leave Details, Load Assignments to Faculty Members during leave, Leave Approval & Rejection etc. LMS works specifically at each Hierarchical Level right from lower Teaching/Non-Teaching Staff to Principal/Director Level. Leave Sanction /Leave Rejection is based on SMS system. LMS is capable in applying leave online, maintaining leave records and tracking all types of leaves availed, checking balance leaves to be availed faculty wise/ Year wise/ Month wise/ Date & Day wise etc. Leave Reports can be printed on desired basis.

- 1. Employee registration with categorization of Teaching and Non-teaching staff etc.
- employee code, department, designation, branch along with personal 2. Defining details.
- 3. Defining Leave Types Casual leave, Earn Leave, Duty leave, Medical Leave, leave without pay etc.
- 4. Application of Leave from staff.
- 5. Staff must assign their work to substitute staff at the time of applying leave.
- 6. Recommendation/Approval of leave by Head of Department.
- 7. Final Approval from Principal/Director.
- 8. Category wise leave report generation.
- 9. Auto updation in Leave Balance.
- 10. Notification of staff assignment, Leave sanction/rejection by SMS.
- 11. Track leaves status.
- 12. Generation of leave history, year/month/week/day wise.
- 13. Leave report can be printed in customize form.
