Program Summary

Under the Ministry of Education' Govt. of India student Exchange under AKAM-EBSB: Visit of students to the paired states was started under this program. Madhya Pradesh is paired with Nagaland and Manipur. Under this program, there are two types of institutes that were identified one is a sender institute, and the other is a receiver institute. The sender institute will identify the group of students from its lot and prominent schools of its state, and the receiver institute will receive the students sent by the sender institute. The receiver institute will facilitate visits about the cultural exchange, food exchange, traditions, sculpture, best practices, etc.

The objective of the program 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat' is to foster national integration by a co-ordinated mutual engagement process between States, Union Territories, Central Ministries, Educational Institutions, and the general public through linguistic, literary, cultural, sports, tourism, and other forms of people-to-people exchanges.

Under this initiative, Madhya Pradesh is paired with Manipur and Nagaland. In this case, the receiver institute appointed by AICTE is IPS Academy. Institute of Engineering and Science, Indore, and the sender institute is Manipur Institute of Technology, Imphal, Manipur. A group of faculty members and students from Manipur Institute of Technology, Imphal, and Schools of Manipur visited the campus of IPS Academy Institute of Engineering and Science Indore for a week. 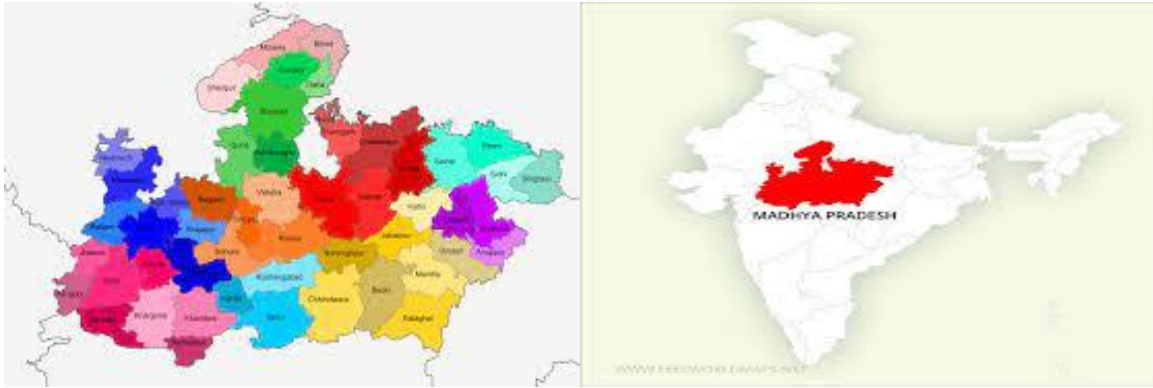

The Madhya Pradesh



Madhya Pradesh is a state in central India. Its capital is Bhopal, and the largest city is Indore, with Jabalpur, Ujjain, Gwalior, Satna, and Guna being the other major cities. Madhya Pradesh is the second largest Indian state by area and the fifth largest state by population with over 72 million residents. It borders the states of Uttar Pradesh to the northeast, Chhattisgarh to the southeast, Maharashtra to the south, Gujarat to the west, and Rajasthan to the northwest.

The area covered by the present-day Madhya Pradesh includes the area of the ancient Avanti Mahajanapada, whose capital Ujjain (also known as Avantika) arose as a major city during the second wave of Indian urbanisation in the sixth century BCE. Subsequently, the region was ruled by the major dynasties of India. The Maratha Empire dominated the majority of the 18th century. After the Anglo-Maratha Wars in the 19th century, the region was divided into several princely states under the British and incorporated into Central Provinces and Berar and the Central India Agency. After India's independence, Madhya Pradesh state was created with Nagpur as its capital: this state included the southern parts of the present-day Madhya Pradesh and northeastern portion of today's Maharashtra. In 1956, this state was reorganised and its parts were combined with the states of Madhya Bharat, Vindhya Pradesh and Bhopal to form the new Madhya Pradesh state, the Marathi-speaking Vidarbha region was removed and merged with the Bombay State. This state was the largest in India by area until 2000, when its southeastern Chhattisgarh region was designated a separate state. Content from <https://en.wikipedia.org/>

The economy of Madhya Pradesh is the 10th-largest in India, with a gross state domestic product (GSDP) of ₹9.17 trillion (US\$120 billion) and has the Country's 26th highest per-capita income of ₹ 109372. Madhya Pradesh ranks 23rd among Indian states in human development index. Rich in mineral resources, Madhya Pradesh has the largest reserves of diamond and copper in India. More than 30% of its area is under forest cover.

The Manipur State



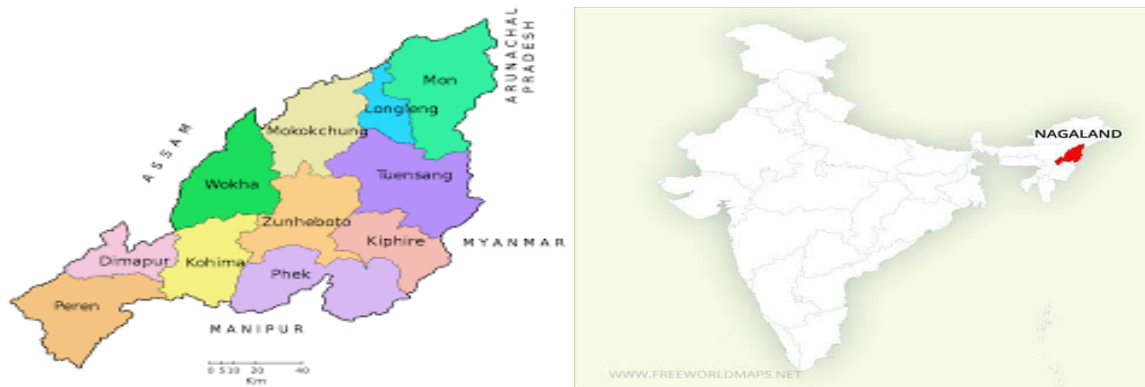
Manipur is a state in Northeast India, with the city of Imphal as its capital. It is bounded by the Indian states of Nagaland to the north, Mizoram to the south and Assam to the west. It also borders two regions of Myanmar, Sagaing Region to the east and Chin State to the south. The state covers an area of 22,327 square kilometres (8,621 sq mi) and has a population of almost 3 million, including the Meiteis, Nagas, Kukis, Zomis and other smaller communities, who speak a variety of Sino-Tibetan languages. Manipur has been at the crossroads of Asian economic and cultural exchange for more than 2,500 years.

By the late 1930s, the princely state of Manipur negotiated with the British administration its preference to continue to be part of the Indian Empire, rather than part of Burma, which was being separated from India. These negotiations were cut short with the outbreak of World War II in 1939. On 21 September 1949, he signed a Merger Agreement, merging the kingdom into India, which led to its becoming a Part C State.

The Meitei represents around 53% of the population of Manipur state, followed by various Naga tribes at 24% and various Kuki/Zomi tribes at 16%. The main language of the state is Meiteilon (also known as Manipuri). Tribals constitute about 41% of the state population (according to 2011 census) According to 2011 census, Hinduism is the major religion in the state, closely followed by Christianity. Other religions include Islam, Sanamahism, Buddhism, and Judaism, etc. Content from <https://en.wikipedia.org/>

Manipur has primarily an agrarian economy, with significant hydroelectric power generation potential. It is connected to other areas by daily flights through Imphal airport, the second largest in north eastern India. Manipur is home to many sports and the origin of Manipuri dance.

The Nagaland State



Nagaland is a state in north eastern India. It is bordered by the state of Arunachal Pradesh to the north, Assam to the west, Manipur to the south and the Sagaing Region of Myanmar to the east. Its capital city is Kohima and its largest city is Dimapur. It has an area of 16,579 square kilometres (6,401 sq mi) with a population of 1,980,602 per the 2011 Census of India, making it one of India's smallest states.

Nagaland became the 16th state of India on 1 December 1963. It has experienced insurgency and inter-ethnic conflict since the 1950s, limiting its economic development.

Agriculture is the state's most important economic activity, accounting for over 70% of its economy. Other significant activities include forestry, tourism, insurance, real estate, and miscellaneous cottage industries. Content from <https://en.wikipedia.org/>

Nagaland lies between the parallels of 95- and 94-degrees east longitude and 25.2 and 27.0 degrees latitude north. It is home to a rich variety of flora and fauna.

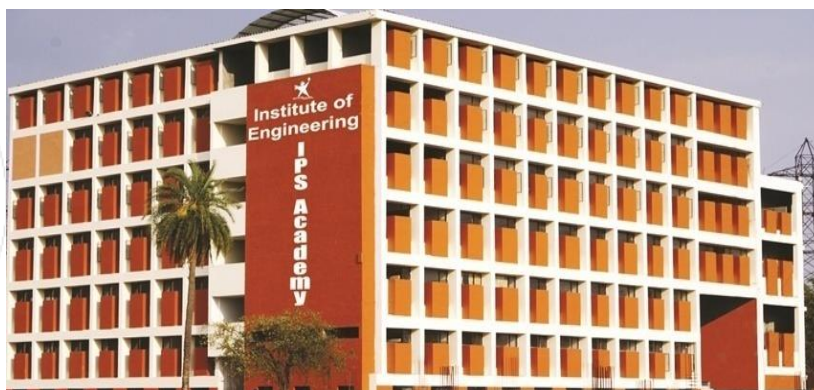

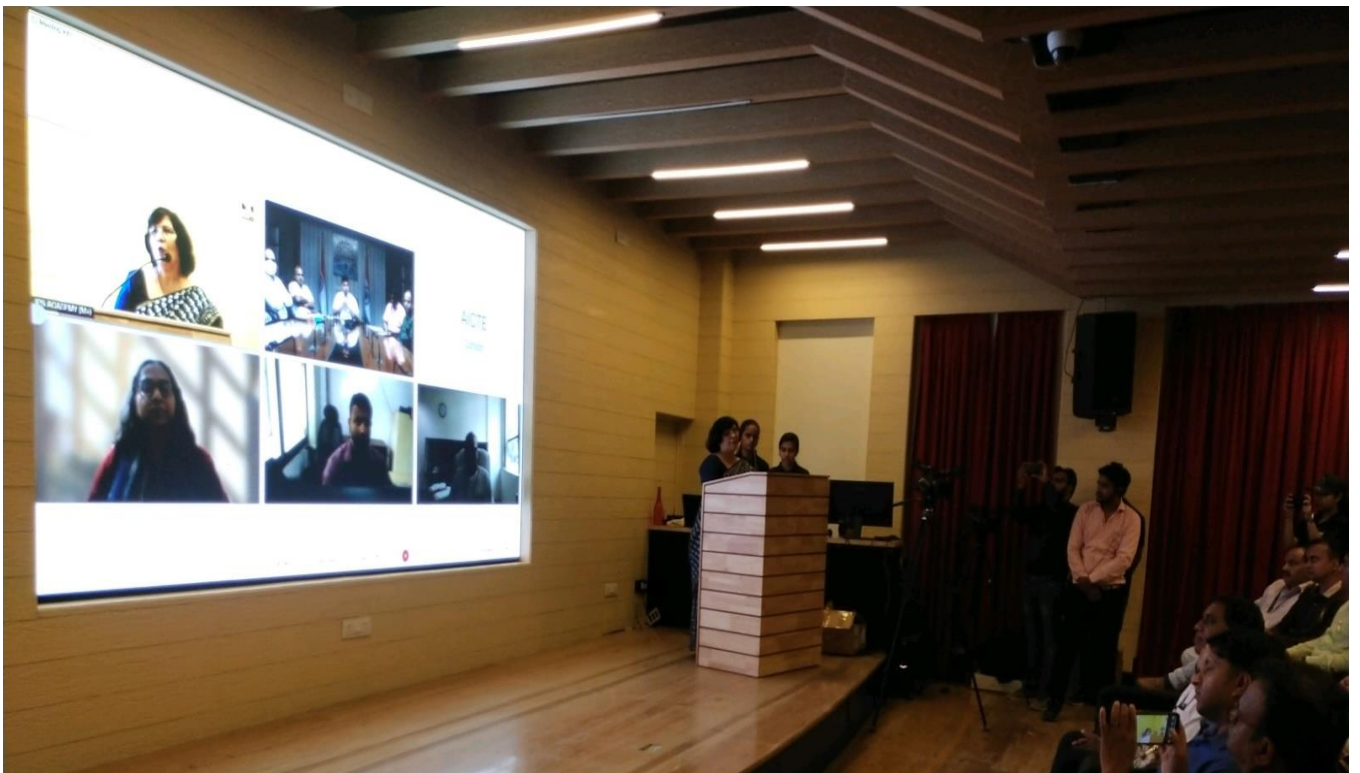

Visit to Dongla Robotics Astronomical Observatory

Dongla is significant in that it lies at the intersection of the Tropic of Cancer and local longitude, which was our ancient Indian Time meridian, and the sun rays are exactly perpendicular during the summer solstice. Dongla Observatory being at 0-degree Cancer makes it very important in India and the World.

Dr. Rajesh Sharma, a Senior Principal Scientist at the Observatory, made special arrangements for the students. Many observatories equipment was displayed with special permission. The officials from the Observatory showed the pulse ring instrument, cone instrument, wall instrument, Bhaskar yantra, and Samrat yantra. The officials gave a detailed explanation, and all the students were fascinated by the observations.

Traditional Malwa food, including Dhokla, Samosa, Milk Cake, Lassi, etc., was arranged for the troops.

The Observatory has a dome of 5 meters and a height of 12.05 meters, with a telescope installed to study stars and planets. Later, Dr. Narendra Nath Patra, a senior professor in the Department of Astronomy and Astro Physics and Space Science, IIT Indore, gave an expert talk about the basics of Space Physics through a presentation.

Cultural and Spiritual Exchange

A visit was made to the Ujjain Jyotirling Mahakaleshwar, one of the twelve Jyotirlings in India. Ujjain, known as the City of Temple, was ruled by Maharaja Vikramaditya and is famous for its holy Maha Kumbh Mela, a gathering attracting more than two crore people every twelve years. After the visit to the temple, the students had local food, including rice, dal, paneer, etc., and then returned to campus.

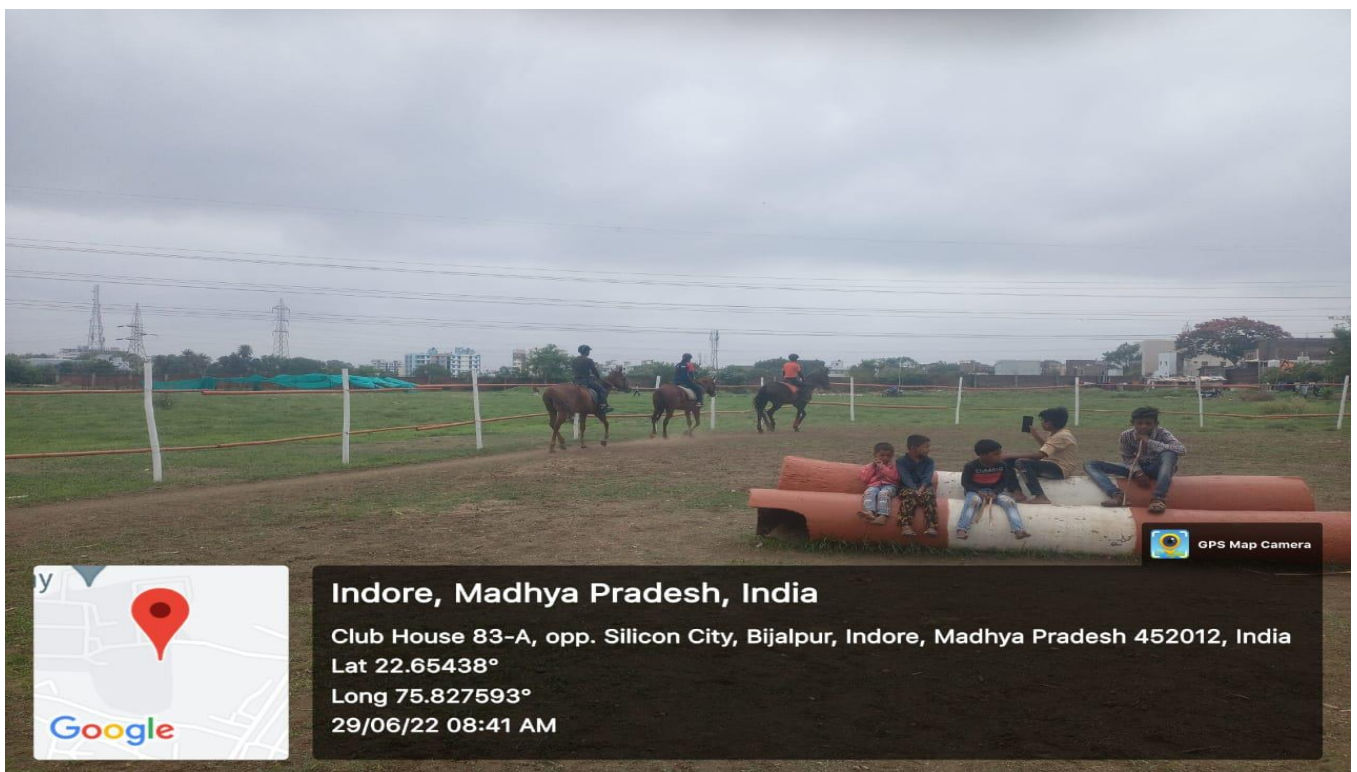
The troop then went to Rajwada, Indore. The students and teachers of Manipur were divided into groups and each group was led by one of IPS Academy volunteers. The BSF personals

accompanying the groups were very helpful and supportive throughout. Students showed their full respect to the men in uniform.

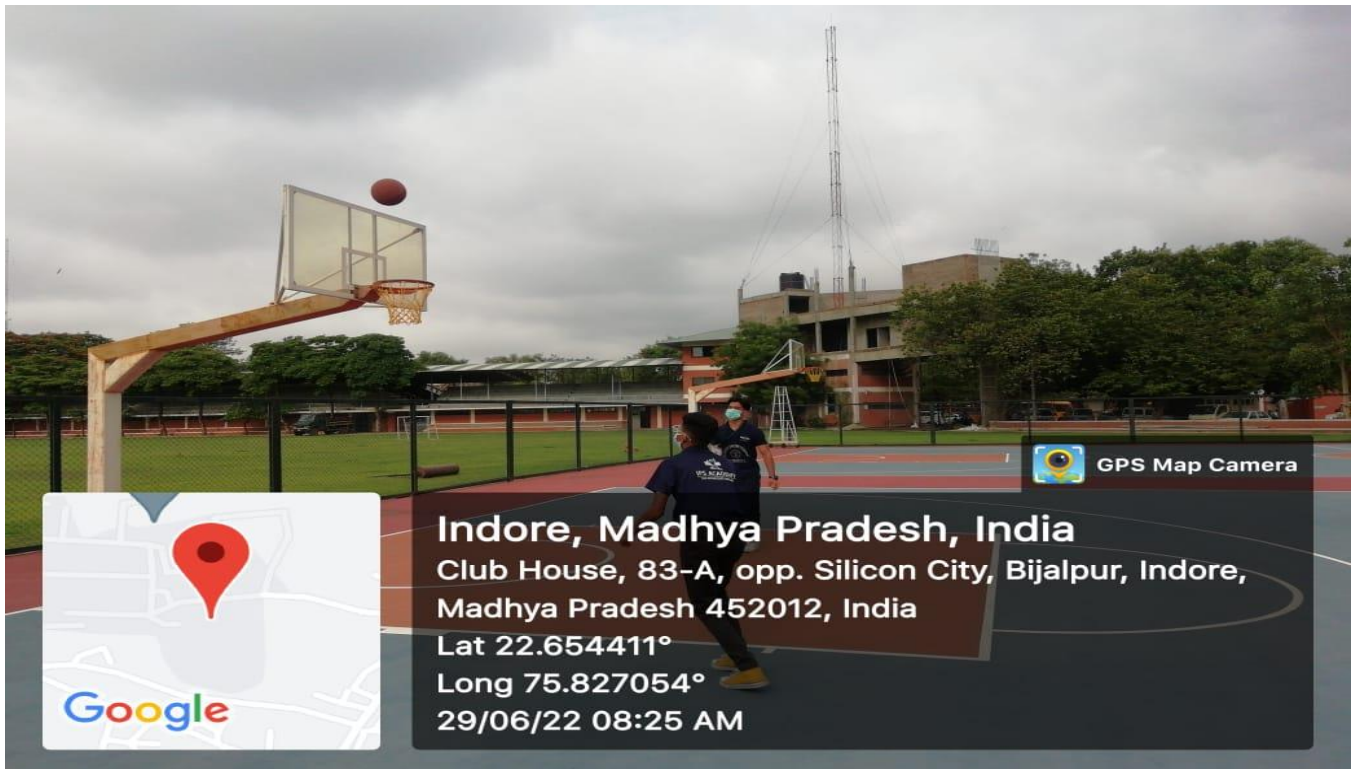

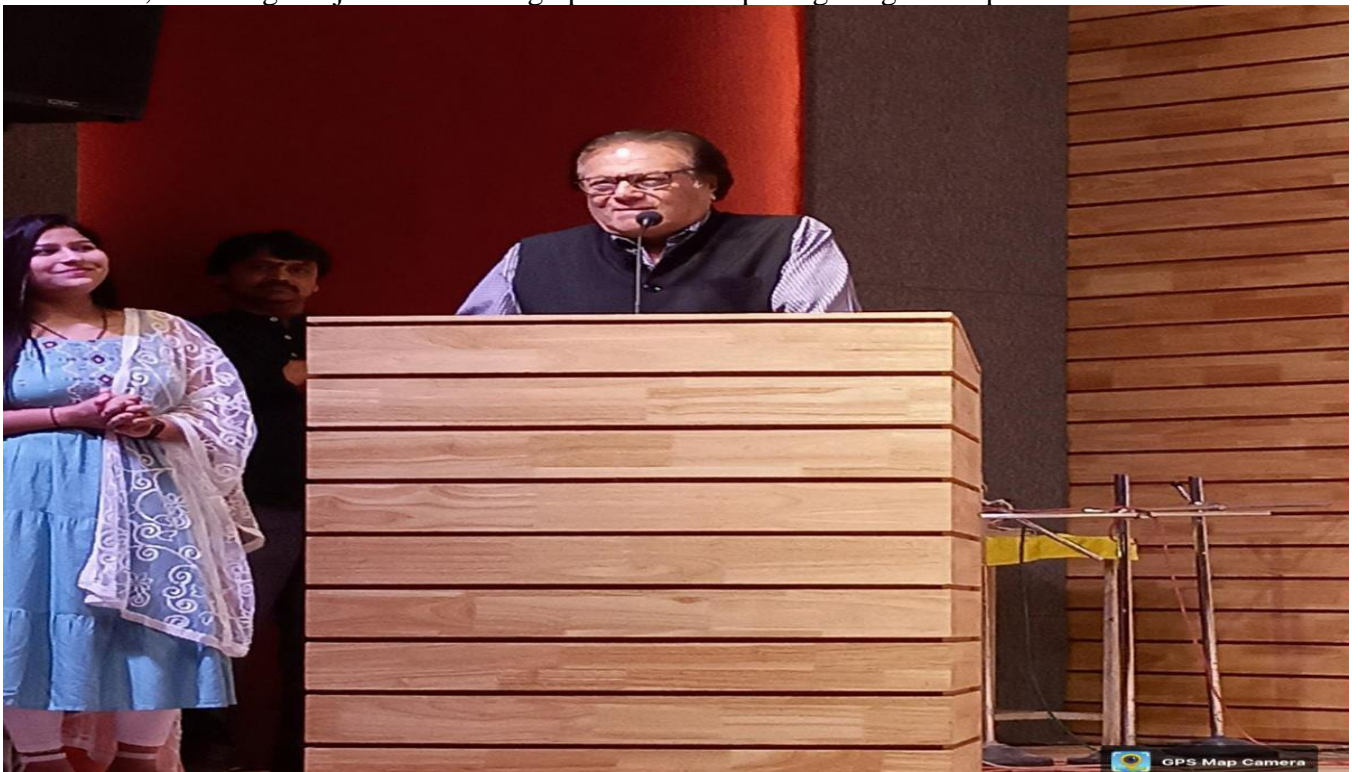
