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# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

FIRE TECHNOLOGY & SAFETY ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT,  
IPS ACADEMY, INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING & SCIENCE

AND

MAHIMA PURESPUN

1. **PARTIES:** This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is made and entered into by and between the Fire Technology & Safety Engineering department of IPS Academy Institute of Engineering & Science, whose address is Knowledge Village AB Road Rajendra Nagar, Indore, Madhya Pradesh 452012, and the Mahima Purespun, whose address is Unnamed Road, Industrial Area, Pithampur, 454775, Pithampur, Madhya Pradesh.
2. **PURPOSE:** The purpose of this MOU is to establish the terms and conditions under which a team comprises of one faculty member, one lab technician and a group of six students from fire technology & safety engineering department will meet and function in the area of hazards control and management at the premises of Mahima Purespun. The team will visit with departmental instruments once in every six month and same will be permitted at the end of Mahima Purespun. The measured data concerning with hazards shall be used in UG and PG projects of students and also the solution given by the team may be incorporated in Mahima Purespun depending upon the practical feasibility and their consideration.
3. **TERM OF MOU:** This MOU is effective upon the day and date last signed and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties to this MOU and shall remain in full force till termination. This MOU may be terminated, without cause, by either party upon one month written notice, which notice shall be delivered by hand or by certified mail to the address listed above.
4. **RESPONSIBILITIES OF FIRE TECHNOLOGY & SAFETY ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT IPS ACADEMY INSTITUTE OF ENGINEERING & SCIENCE:**
  - a) The team from Fire Technology & Safety Engineering department IPS Academy Institute of Engineering & Science will arrange their own lodging, boarding and travelling arrangement from their destination to Mahima Purespun.

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- b) The team will carry relevant instruments such as integrated sound level meter, noise dosimeter and air sampling pump unit and any other relevant instrument for the measurement of hazards associated in different sections in Mahima Purespun.
- c) The team will submit a copy of collected data after observations and analysis to the Mahima Purespun for their consideration in safety management.
- d) The team shall not be eligible for any stipend or remuneration charges from Mahima Purespun and it will be solely for quality education purpose.
- e) The team will ensure to abide by rules and safety norms of Mahima Purespun during visit and during hazard monitoring activities.
- f) The data collected by team will be used in education purpose only and kept confidential.

6. **RESPONSIBILITIES OF MAHIMA PURESPUN:**

- a) The Mahima Purespun will permit and arrange team visit for Fire Technology & Safety Engineering department IPS Academy Institute of Engineering & Science once in every six month. The date and time of visit will be fixed based on mutual discussion and consent of both parties.
- b) The Mahima Purespun will not be eligible for any cost/charges for the team visit.
- c) The Mahima Purespun will deploy a responsible technical officer to coordinate with the team to carryout hazard monitoring activities in different sections of Mahima Purespun.
- d) The Mahima Purespun will ensure the safety of team members and associated instruments during hazard monitoring activities.

7. **GENERAL PROVISIONS:**

- A. **Amendments:** Either party may request changes to this MOU. Any changes, modifications, revisions or amendments to this MOU which are mutually agreed upon by and between the parties to this MOU shall be incorporated by written instrument, and effective when executed and signed by all parties to this MOU.
- B. **Applicable Law:** The construction, interpretation and enforcement of this MOU shall be governed by the laws of the State of Madhya Pradesh and local bye laws.

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C. **Entirety of agreement:** This MOU, consisting of Three pages, represents the entire and integrated agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior representations and agreements, whether written or oral.

8. **SIGNATURES:** In witness whereof, the parties to this MOU through their duly authorized representatives have executed this MOU on the days and dates set out below, and certify that they have read, understood, and agreed to the terms and conditions of this MOU as set forth herein.
