All the students are hereby informed that the summer term will commence from 1st May 2025 to facilitate:

- The failed students to attend the courses in which they have failed to clear the backlogs.
- Give an opportunity to a student with CGPA below 5.
- The final year students who have missed the first division marginally.

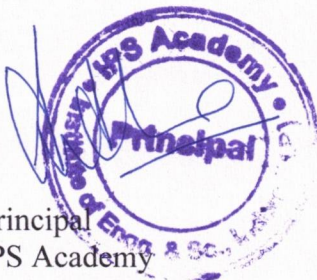
It is to be noted that the students following under category a, b & c above can take maximum of 3 subjects (theory & practical of the same subject shall be treated as 2 subjects). The academic activity in summer term shall be at double the rate as compared to main semester.

The classes for the summer term shall be held as per schedule mention in the calendar. The student offering the summer term shall be required to appear for Continuous In-semester Evaluation (CIE) & End Sem Examination (ESE) both. All such students, shall be required to pay the prescribed fees of Rs. 3,500/- (inclusive of an examination fees) per subject within the stipulated time.

It may be noted that a student who either dropped or detained in a course during the main semester is not allowed to register for that course in summer term.

All the students under category a, b, & c above shall be required to apply in the enclosed format to the respective HoD's by 30th April 2025, positively.
