
Insights From Participants




The event encouraged students to draw from personal experiences and interests, creating artworks that resonated with a broader audience.








Kavya Utsav Competition


Event Highlights



performing arts. Their combined experience allowed for a thoughtful and well-rounded evaluation of each poetic performance.


Entries were judged based on the following criteria:

- Clarity of Delivery and Presentation Style




Audience Engagement







Outcome
